Key Concepts

Fossil fuels are created over time from the accumulation of dead animals on the sea bed and are a non-renewable resource.

Plastics (derived from petroleum) are persistent in the environment and harm marine life.

Reducing plastic waste and correct disposal of plastic is vitally important to protecting the marine environment.
